ROUND 1 (Online Exam-1)November 12, 2019, 12:00-2:00 PM at the Lab

- 1. Scope of the competition: Pure Math, Basic Math and Applied Mathematics.
- References: Pure Math, Applied Math and Basic Math handouts, College Algebra with Trigonometry 7th edition book (Barnett, et al)
- 2. The Online exam (MCQs) is given to all participants. There are 30 questions for 1 hour (10 Applied Mathematics, 10 Basic Math, 10 Pure Math).
- 3. The top 25 students will be selected for the next round (Round 2)
- 4. In case of tie in the marks, the time of submission will be considered.
- 5. Calculators are not allowed.
- 6. Interested students must register their names, ID and phone numbers to their respective Math lecturer.
- *Lecturers shall provide soft copy of Basic, Pure Math and Applied Math handouts.

ROUND 2 (Online Exam-2) November 19, 2017, 12:00-12:30 PM at the Lab

- 1. Scope of the competition: Pure Math, Basic Math and Applied Mathematics. (Difficulty level is increased from Round 1)
 References: Pure Math, Applied Math and Basic Math handouts, College Algebra with Trigonometry 7th edition book (Barnett, et al.)
- 2. The online exam (MCQs) is given to all 25 participants. There are 15 questions for 30 minutes (5 Applied Mathematics, 5 Basic Math, 5 Pure Math).
- 3. The top 10 students will be selected for the next round (Round 3)
- 4. In case of tie in the marks, the time of submission will be considered.
- 5. Calculators are not allowed.

Round 3 (Rapid Oral Round) November 19, 2019 1:00 – 2:00 PM at Room A-229

- 1. Scope of the competition: Mental Ability and Reasoning
- References: Two hours class of awareness of the mental ability and reasoning topics to be conducted for the students who qualify for the Round 2 by the math faculty between 12th November and 18th November 2019.
- 2. Oral exam (MCQs) using power point presentation. There are 10 questions, each question will be displayed for 2 minutes and each participant has to submit his/her answer within 2 minutes.
- 3. The top three (3) students will receive first, second and third prizes.
- 4. In case of tie in the marks, a tiebreaking question will be given.
- 5. All ten (10) participants in round 3 will receive certificates.
- *Round 3 will be conducted in the presence of section faculties, HoSs of IT and all HoDs.
